Chromebook Basic Information

- Chromebook rollout within the 1st 3 weeks of school
- Keep same Chromebook each year
- Chromebook is like textbook, bring charged and ready for use everyday
- NO STICKERS or markings can be placed on Chromebooks
- End User License Agreement on website (EULA)

Chromebook Insurance

- Insurance Cost: \$30
- Covers 1st accidental damage
- Second break repair is \$60.00
- Covers theft -Police report must be filed
- Will not cover theft from unattended vehicles
- Will not cover intentional damage
- Will not cover if CB is lost
- Will not cover cost of charger. (Replacement cost is \$35)

Attendance for Credit

- 90 % Rule
 - Includes excused & unexcused absences
 - Obligation of making up time (multiple opportunities will be made available to make up time)
 - Retention is possible for excessive absences

Dress Code





